





## Get free energy-saving advice and upgrades

The Energy Conservation Assistance Program (ECAP) can help make your home more comfortable, safe and energy efficient.



At no cost for qualifying low-income households, it includes:

- A review of your home's energy use and energy-saving advice from an energy coach
- Free installation of products such as energy-saving LED light bulbs, water-efficient showerheads, weatherstripping, carbon monoxide detectors and more
- For homes that qualify, free upgrades such as insulation, an ENERGY STAR<sup>®</sup> fridge or a high-efficiency gas furnace



★ Must meet the income requirements. For example, a family of four with an annual household income under \$73,800 that lives in a detached house, duplex, townhouse or manufactured/mobile home would be eligible for the program. Full terms and conditions and eligibility criteria are available at fortisbc.com/ecap.

★ Products installed depend on the individual characteristics of the home and other program criteria. Only FortisBC natural gas heated, FortisBC electrically heated or BC Hydro electrically heated single family homes, manufactured/mobile homes, townhouses and duplexes are eligible for insulation upgrades. Other program criteria apply. Apartment units and homes with other heating fuel types are not eligible for insulation. Offer subject to change.
